DEADLINE: DECEMBER 15, 2010

Papers are welcome in any area of study normally covered by our society and will be judged in two categories:

- (1) Hebrew Scriptures/Ancient Near Eastern Studies, and
- (2) New Testament/Christian Origins.

Stipend: \$300.00 in each category

Papers must be no more than twenty-five pages in length including notes, typed, double-spaced, with notes gathered at the end. An abstract of 100 words or less must accompany the submitted paper. Papers that exceed twenty-five (25) pages or otherwise do not comply with these guidelines will not be considered. The paper should be 15 pages of text and no more than 25 pages in length. Papers should not have been previously submitted.

The recipients of these awards will be expected to attend the regional conference and read their papers during the appropriate sections. The recipients are encouraged to submit their original papers to **PROCEEDINGS, Eastern Great Lakes and Midwest Biblical Societies.**
